- S.K. Davis earned the Knights Templar Cross of Honor for exceptional and meritorious service rendered in the Order, far beyond the service usually expected of an officer or member. This award is presented to only one Sir Knight in Florida annually.
- S. K. Davis has been a loyal Sir Knight since 1988. He served Springtime as Eminent Commander in 1992 and has been Treasurer since 2001 His loyalty and dedication is still seen at every convocation, where Sir Knight Davis is one of the first ones there to help set up and one of the last ones to leave after helping to put everything away.

Right Eminent Friend also presented S.K. Donald T. Harriott, Past Eminent Commander from Sunshine Commandery No. 20, with the Knight Commander of the Temple award. The Knight Commander of the Temple (KCT) is the second highest decoration of the Grand Encampment. One or more Sir Knights may be honored each year in a jurisdiction with this award, recognizing the honoree's service to the causes of Templary.

The officers of Springtime Commandery No. 40 were also recognized for earning the Richard J. Carr Trophy for excellence in 2014-2015. The Richard J. Carr Trophy is awarded annually to the Commandery which demonstrates the highest level of proficiency in opening a Commandery with nine (9) Sir Knights (commonly called the 9-man opening). The Inspector General graded Springtime on the following:

Precision in floor work, accuracy in spoken passages, neatness/ completeness in uniforms, completion within allotted timeframe, and attendance of elected and appointed officers.

Also congratulations to Sir Knight Carl E. Gilmore, Right Eminent Past Grand Commander, and Past Eminent Commander of Springtime Commandery No. 40, who was elected Grand Treasurer for all of the Grand York Rite bodies at the Grand convention in May at Panama City Beach.
